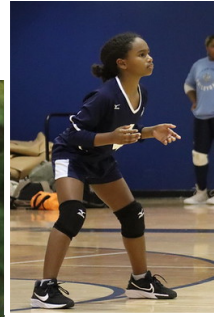
Athletics
